

IRA QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD) FORM

IRA QCDs or IRA Charitable Rollovers, as they are sometimes called, are an increasingly popular way for donors 70 ½ years and older to support the charities that matter to them. You can make up to \$108,000 in tax-free charitable distributions annually, lowering your taxable income, and, if you're 72 or older, helping you to meet your minimum distribution requirement or RMD.

As an IRS registered 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, Clean Water for Haiti is a Qualified Charitable Distribution approved recipient.
